Uniform items

- Red or white polo shirt (with or without school logo)
- Red sweatshirt or cardigan (with or without school logo)
- Grey or black skirt, grey pinafore, grey or black trousers or grey school shorts
- Summer dresses (red check only)
- Sensible black shoes or black trainers (majority of trainer should be black)

Games and PE

- Black shorts/leggings/jogging bottoms
- Plain red t-shirt
- Plimsolls/trainers
- Red sweatshirt (with or without logo)
- Hair at or below shoulder length to be tied up

It is essential that all items of clothing are marked clearly with the child's name.

Jewellery

We encourage children to not wear jewellery in school for safety purposes.

We encourage children not to wear necklaces in school, however, we understand that some children wear a necklace that is special or holds significant for them. Children can wear one simple necklace worn under their t-shirt or sweatshirt/cardigan. The necklace, if worn, must be taken off for physical activity (PE, swimming, sporting games at break or lunch).

Children can wear only one bracelet on their wrist, which must be removed for physical activity (PE and swimming) and the child must be able to put their own bracelet on and off.

Children who have pierced ears must only wear studs for safety reasons. If a child wears jewellery that isn't in line with the school uniform policy, they will be asked to remove it.

Fitness watches

Normal school rules for PE are that watches should be removed before the lesson. However, as the watches are used to measure fitness, we appreciate that the children will want to wear them.

For most physical activities, it will be safe for them to be worn. However, for some outdoor games it will not be suitable; teachers will advise the children when to remove them.
